So together with all the right, title, interest, claim and demand of us and to the aforesaid parcel of Land with its appurtenances thereto belonging, Except all the Cypress trees eighteen inches and upwards in diameter at the stump, all the pine trees and logs fifteen inches and upwards in diameter at the stump and all the Dogwood trees fifteen inches and upwards in diameter at the stump all of which the said Poles except and reserve to themselves, the said Poles having heretofore sold the said timber herein excepted to one Eckst Hardin and George D. Old to have and to hold the aforesaid parcel of Land unto him the said Joseph G. Crumples his heirs and assigns forever and the said Harison D. Poles, Ben. C. Poles and wife Caroline R. Poles for themselves their heirs executors and administrators doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Joseph G. Crumples his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid parcel of Land against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
