 State of Virginia, Witnessed: that the said Jacob Bryant and Temperance his wife
 have for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to them in hand
 paid by the said John R. Williams the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have Bargained, sold and conveyed and do by these presents bargain, sell and
 confirm unto the said John R. Williams his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 tract or parcel of Land lying and being within the County of Southampton T^h Paulmundo
 Smith by the lands of Margaret Beal, West by the Lands belonging to the heirs
 of Jonathan Bryant dec'd. North by the lands of Allen Beal and East by the land
 belonging to Mrs. Deborah and Elyabeth Bryant, containing thirty eight acres
 or thereabouts more or less. To have and to hold the above said tract or parcel
 of Land to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John R. Williams
 to him and his heirs forever and we the said Jacob Bryant and Temperance
 his wife do warrant and defend the just right and title of any lawful claim
 or claims of any person or persons whatsoever unto the said John R. Williams his
