 have for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to them in hand  
 paid by the said John R. Williams the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 have Bargained, Sold and confirmed and do by these presents. Bargain, sell and  
 confirm unto the said John R. Williams his heirs and assigns forever in exchange  
 here or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton & in the  
 south by the lands of Margaret Beal, West by the lands belonging to the heirs  
 of Jonathan Bryant dec'd. North by the lands of Allen Beal and East by the land  
 belonging to Mrs. Deborah and Eliza both Bryant, containing thirty eight acres  
 to the same more or less. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel  
 of Land to the my proper use and behoof of him the said John R. Williams  
 to him and his heirs forever and w<sup>t</sup>. the said Jacob Bryant and Temperance  
 his wife do warrant and defend the just right and title of any lawfull claim  
 or claims of any person or persons whatsoever unto the said John R. Williams his  
 heirs and assigns forever. And witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands
