 in fee all of their several & respective interests & share portions in & to the real and
 personal estate of every sort and description whereof the said Anne Proctor did
 possess & was entitled to, that is to say, each one the said parties for themselves
 respectively does hereby convey, assign & transfer each ones entire interest and
 portion in said deceased estate to which each one is distributary as aforesaid
 may be entitled: So have & hold the same as aforesaid to her the said Anne
 Proctor. And the said parties of the first part do hereby authorize, empower and
 direct the personal representatives or administrators of the said Anne Proctor
 to pay over to the said Anne Proctor the said personal estate of the said deceased
