This Dec^r made this 1st day of December, 1857 Between William B. Hall
and Frances E. Hall his wife of the first part and Samuel B. Kello the trustee of the
other part: Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of one dollar the said William B. Hall
and Frances E. Hall his wife do grant unto the said Samuel B. Kello trustee in trust, the
following property, to wit: Their interest in and to a certain tract of Land in Southampton County,
known as the George Holloman place. Their interest in the following diverse negroes to-wit:
man Henry and woman Sarah also 2 Horses, one buggy and a head of stock of cattle
sheep &c. all household and kitchen furniture all farming implements and all crops of all description that may be found upon the plantation upon which
said Hall resides in trust to secure A. B. Wigham in the sum of three hundred and twenty
Dollars and 70¢ due Dec^r 1/1857 and also to secure A. B. Wigham from any claim
from abroad due by Elliott D. Bailey due to A. B. Wigham five to Geo. A. Hol-
man due the 1st Jan^y 1855, also to secure said Wigham in a bond on which there
is a balance of 56¢ due him as guardian of Geo. A. Holloman and to secure Sam-
uel B. Kello in the sum of Two hundred dollars - The condition of the above obligation is
such that if the said W^m B. Hall shall pay the above obligations and also the sum of
One hundred & twenty eight & thirty six cts due M. D. Denton when demanded then this
obligation to be void. If he should fail to pay said debts when demanded at
the said Saml. B. Kello as trustee shall at the request of the said Wigham
or Kello set up and sell for cash the above named property and after paying
aforesaid Kello and Wigham their debts mentioned pay M. D. Denton his debt
and the balance pay over to W^m B. Hall.
