This Deed made and entered into this 11th day of December 1857, between Melham Mungie of the County of Sunderhampton, State of Virginia, of one part and Joshua Beeler of the aforesaid County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of Five hundred dollars in hand paid to the said Mel^m Mungie by the said Joshua Beeler at or before executing and delivery of these presents, the said Mel^m Mungie doth bargain, sell and release unto the said Joshua Beeler a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County containing Two hundred and forty five acres more or less situate on the Eastern Side of the place including the forty five acres which the said Mel^m Mungie purchased of Elizabeth Scott and adjoining the lands of John Beeler, Mel^m E. Scott, John C. Scott, Harriand, James and others - The said Mel^m Mungie warrants generally the title to the forty five acres as purchased of Elizabeth Scott and such right and title to the other Two hundred acres as was vested in him from Mel^m Beale, by deed and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of the aforesaid County and such title only, the same having been sold by L. Q. Edwards as trustee and Eng. A. M. Munsom became purchaser, who sold the same to the aforesaid Mel^m Beale and the said Mel^m Beale sold the same to the said Mel^m Mungie and the said Mel^m Mungie now sells the same to the said J. Beeler with said right as was granted to the said Eng. A. M. Munsom from the said L. Q. Edwards, as trustee and such only.
