Wills both defendants with Clerk's Office of Southampton County, State of Virginia, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, of one part, and George D. Old of the aforesaid County and State of the other part, Witnesseth; that for and in consideration of twenty five hundred and seventy five Dollars in hand paid by the said Geo. D. Old at or before the executing and delivery of these presents, The said William D. Moore and Virginia W. Moore his wife in their right and the aforesaid W^m Mufsee in his right, and the said W^m E. Gay as trustee as aforesaid did bargain, sell, grant and release to the said George D. Old, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County containing four hundred and sixty five acres more or less, adjoining the lands of Mrs. Mary Baxter on the North, Edw. D. Williams on the South, Mrs. Margaret Moore on the East and the lands belonging to the heirs of the late Richard Parker dec'd on the West, The said William D. Moore and Virginia W. Moore his wife and the said W^m Mufsee in his right do warrant generally the right and title to the aforesaid Geo. D. Old against all persons whomsoever and the said W^m E. Gay relinquish all right as trustee as aforesaid by instrument from the aforesaid Mufsee, Parker and Wills all being present.
