Myrick's line, a corner for said Sarah E. Vick thence along his line South 24 1/4 poles to a post a corner in his line thence S 85° E 64 poles to the beginning. Barnes her heirs and assigns forever another said Kirby Vick and Maria H. his wife, Joseph H. Ellsworth and Elizabeth his wife William H. Ellsworth and Maria J. his wife, and Caleb E. Vick and Sarah E. his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Caroline L. Barnes, her heirs, Executors, and assigns that they will by their presents tenants and assigns defend all their said rights, titles and interests in and to the aforesaid piece of parcel of land against the claims or demands of all (and every other person or persons whatsoever.
