This Indenture made and entered into on the 4th day of July in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty seven, between James Barnes and Caroline L. his wife, Joseph H. Ellsworth and Elizabeth his wife, William H. Ellsworth and Martha J. his wife, and Caleb E. Vick and Sarah E. his wife, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Maria H. Vick the wife of Ruby Vick, of the same County and State of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said first parties to this Indenture for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Maria H. Vick, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto her the said Maria H. Vick her heirs and assigns forever all their rights, titles and interests in and to one certain piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's containing nine acres be the same more or less it being the said Maria H. Vick's share of the tract of land which she and the said Caroline L. Barnes, Joseph H. Ellsworth (William H. Ellsworth and Sarah E. Vick inherited from their mother Sarah Ellsworth, wife of Selah Ellsworth (their father) and her heirs as follows, Beginning at a corner for Caroline L. Barnes in John D. McGuire's line, thence along said Caroline L. Barnes S. 21° W. 24 1/4 poles to a post, thence thence S. 65° E. 7 1/4 poles to a post standing in Capt. James Majors' line now Caswell Woods, thence along said Majors' line S. 18° E. 12 poles thence N. 81° E. 2 1/2 poles to a small gum a corner for John D. McGuire thence along his line of marked trees to the beginning to have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thence belonging unto the said Maria H. Vick her heirs and assigns forever, and the said James Barnes and Caroline L. his wife, Joseph H. Ellsworth and Elizabeth his wife, William H. Ellsworth and Martha J. his wife, and Caleb E. Vick and Sarah E. his wife for themselves their heirs, Executors and administrators hereby consent and agree to and with the said Maria H. Vick her heirs, Executors and administrators and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend all their said rights, titles and interests in and to the aforesaid piece or parcel of land against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
