Vick, parties to a certain Deed bearing date with 4th day of July 1857 and who were personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from their husbands and having the Deed aforesaid fully explained to them they then said Caroline L. Barnes, Elizabeth Ellsworth, Martha J. Ellsworth and Sarah E. Vick acknowledged the same to be their act and deed and declared that they wished not to retract it. Ellsworth parties as aforesaid thereto, by the oath of Robt. T. Barnes a subscribing witness thereto, and was admitted to record.

Vick of the same County and State of the other part; Witnesseth that the said first parties to this Indenture for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Sarah E. Vick at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto her the said Sarah E. Vick her heirs and assigns forever all their rights, titles and interests in and to one certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's containing ten and three fourth acres be the same more or less, it being the said Sarah E. Vick's share of the tract of land which she and the said Maria H. Vick, Caroline
