Vick her heirs and assigns forever and the said Kirby Vick and Maria H. his wife James Barnes and Caroline L. his wife Joseph H. Ellsworth and Elizabeth his wife and William N. Ellsworth and Maria J. his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Sarah C. Vick her heirs, Executors, Admins and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend all their said rights, titles and interests in and to the aforesaid piece or parcel of land against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons who demand.
