This Indenture made and entered into the 14<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty seven, between Joseph H. Ellsworth and Elizabeth his wife, William N. Ellsworth and Martha J. his wife, Kirby Vick and Maria A. his wife, James Barnes and Caroline L. his wife and Caleb E. Vick and Sarah E. his wife all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Caswell Ellsworth of the same County and State of the other part, testifies that the said first parties to this Indenture for and in consideration of the sum of forty two dollars paid to the said Joseph H. and William N. Ellsworth by the said Caswell Ellsworth the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by them have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the said Caswell Ellsworth his Heirs and assigns forever all their right titles and interests in and to one certain piece or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's containing eighteen and three fourth acres be the same more or less it being the said Joseph H. Ellsworth's and part of William N. Ellsworth's shares of the tract of land which they and the said Maria A. Vick, Caroline L. Barnes and Sarah E. Vick inherited from their mother Sarah Ellsworth wife of Selah Ellsworth (their father) the said Maria A. Vick, L. Barnes and Sarah E. Vick and their heirs lands being made parties to this Deed in consideration that the said Joseph H. and William N. Ellsworth have this day relinquished their rights to them in their respective shares of the said tract of land; the said eighteen and three fourth acres of land hereby conveyed is bounded as follows, Beginning at a post standing in Capt. Barnes Major's line a corner of said Caswell Ellsworth thence along said Major's line N 15° E 17 poles to a post a corner for said Maria A. Vick, thence along her line N 63° W 78 1/2 poles to a post a corner for said Caroline L. Barnes thence along her line same corner N 63° W 64 poles to a post her corner in Sarah E. Vick's line thence along said Sarah E. Vick's line South 30 poles to a small black gum tree standing in said Caswell Ellsworth's line; thence along his line S 18 1/2 E 129 1/2 poles to the beginning. To have and to hold the above described piece or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereunto belonging unto him the said Caswell Ellsworth his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose and behoof of him the said Caswell Ellsworth his heirs and assigns forever and the said Joseph H. Ellsworth and Elizabeth his wife, William N. Ellsworth and Martha J. his wife Kirby Vick and Maria A. his wife, James Barnes and Caroline L. his wife and Caleb E.
