Marshall of the other part, all of the County of Southampton State of N.Y.: Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars wherewith paid to said Barcus he the said Barcus & wife do bargain, sell & grant to said Marshall a certain parcel or lot of land lying in Town of Southampton Co. I. H. bounded by Jessup's road on south & by the Lands of R. Bennett on west & Ruth and in east by the lot of said A. H. Marshall containing by Survey from R. Bennett to said Barcus, one eighth of an acre And the said Barcus & wife do warrant the right of title generally to said A. H. Marshall As witness our hands & seals this 25th day of Feb: 1856.
