

This Deed made the 25th day of Feb'y one thousand eight hundred & fifty six between Allen Bacon and Ellen his wife of one part and A. M. Russell of the other part, all of the County of Southampton State of Va. Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars which was paid to said Bacon he the said Bacon & wife do bargain, sell & grant to said Russell a certain & parcel or lot of land lying in Trimble's Southampton Co. Va. bounded by James's road on South by the Lands of R. Bennett on West & North and on East by the lot of said A. M. Russell containing by survey from R. Bennett to said Bacon, one eight of an acre. And the said Bacon & wife do warrant the right of title generally to said A. M. Russell. As Witness our hands & seals this 25th day of Feb'y 1856

Soper of the other part, Witnesseth that for valuable consideration the said John F. Small grants unto the said Morrison R. Soper the whole of the Mill with the Land thereto attached being about one hundred acres known as Morris's Mill lying in the County of Southampton, it being the same whereof Henry Moore did die.
