

This Deed made this 11th day of November 1857, between all Jo. Blunt, Geo. W. Peete of the one part and Ed. M. Maffentbury of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Jo. Blunt, Geo. W. Peete and Geo. M. Maffentbury do grant unto the said Ed. M. Maffentbury a tract of land lying in the 10th Sec. of Southampton containing Five Acres & Two acres adjoining the land of W. H. Peete 57th emergency of said tract of land from Jas. Parker, to the said Ed. Maffentbury of the first part by a plat of said land made by Thos. R. Almel and filed with the said Jo. Blunt's Deed in emergency. In trust to secure a bond executed this day by the said Ed. Maffentbury to J. W. Parker for the purchase money due from them to the said Parker for the said land amounting to Eleven Hundred (\$1100) Dollars due and in payment June 19th 1855. Witness the following signatures
