

County on the nineteenth day of September in the year 1853 convey and grant to the said J. Parker (as trustee) for the benefit of one Elijah Wilms a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the said County containing four hundred and fifteen acres more or less and bounded by the lands of the said Doctor by the Massena Swamp by the lands belonging to the heirs of William Bell by the lands of Richard Simmons or his heirs by the lands of John Scarborough and by the public road leading from Jerusalem to Breda for more minute description of boundaries see deed from Wilms & wife to the said Henderson recorded September 19<sup>th</sup> 1853, A.D.

And whereas the said tract has by order of the said Wilms sold at public auction the said real estate for cash and the said Doctor became the purchaser on the 23<sup>rd</sup> December 1857 for one thousand and fifty dollars the receipt of which sum from him the said Doctor is hereby acknowledged. Now this deed witnesseth that the said Parker does hereby grant and convey to the said Doctor all such right title & interest in and to the whole of the said real estate as may be in any manner vested in him as trustee as aforesaid.

This deed made the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December, 1857, between John M. Gulley of the first part and Elizabeth Phillips of the second part, witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars in hand paid by the said Elizabeth Phillips to and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John M. Gulley Trustee, granted bargain and sold unto the said Elizabeth Phillips a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton on the South side of Northway river near the Cypress Bridge land as follows: Commencing at a Spruce as a new corner in S<sup>th</sup> John M. Gulley line for Henry Blaw, James Wallace, and the said Elizabeth Phillips thence east along a new chopped line to a deep ravine thence the run to a large pine thence Southeast to the intersection with the old line formerly Henry Blaw's now said Gulley's thence along said line to the corner of the field formerly Blaw's thence South along a new chopped line to a pine corner in S<sup>th</sup> H. Bishop's line, thence West along said Bishop's line to a corner saw wood in Henry Blaw's line, thence along said Blaw's line to the intersection with Owen Vick line, thence along Owen Vick's line to the Cypress Bridge road, thence north along said road to the beginning supposed to contain fifty acres be the same more or less. I, the said Elizabeth Phillips hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal, the day & date first above written.
