

This Deed made the 5th day of January A.D. 1858, between William S. Moore of the one part and William E. Gay of the other part, Winchester; that the said William S. Moore doth grant unto the said W^m E. Gay as trustee all the right, title and interest which he the said W^m S. Moore has in all the property which is conveyed in these Deeds of Trust executed by him to W^m E. Gay, to wit, the one dated the 23rd day of June 1857 to secure William Mumfere and the other dated the 27th day of June 1857 to secure Godwin Parker and James W. 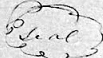
