

This Indenture made this sixteenth day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven between James Barnes of Springfield, Massachusetts and Charlotte A. his wife of the first part and Henry M. Baker of New York City of State of the second part, witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty five thousand dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part at or before the instant delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargains and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said party of the second part his heirs & assigns a certain tract of land lying in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia containing about one thousand one hundred & seventy two and half acres to the same more or less being the same tract of land which was conveyed to William Ward & James Barnes by Joseph S. Liles wife, Arthur Middleka & George B. Middleka by deed bearing date the twenty ninth day of December One thousand eight hundred and forty nine and by a subsequent conveyance of the said William Ward and wife to said James Barnes by deeds dated in the fifth day of February AD 1850 and in the twenty first day of May AD 1852 to which deeds record in the Clerk's office of the County Court of Southampton County aforesaid reference is hereby made. Together with all singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, to have & to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all the said privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Henry M. Baker party of the second part aforesaid and his heirs forever.

And the said parties of the first part for themselves and their heirs respectively do severally covenant with said Henry M. Baker his heirs & assigns that they will warrant and defend the title to said land and its privileges and appurtenances aforesaid to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against the claims of themselves and of all & every person claiming by through or under them or either of them, but against the claims of no other person whatsoever.
