

1857, W^m Mufee, trustee in a deed of Trust^t from John R. Williams to Dennis Ewing persons can record in Southampton County Court, laid before your Commissioner, a statement of all monies received by him from sales of the trust property and also a statement of the disbursements made by him and the vouchers for the same. That the Commissioner may add the said trustee into the list of Trustees whose accounts were before him for settlement which was posted at the front door of the Courthouse of this County on the first day of the County Court after County held at the Octagon last, and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed the foregoing amount of the said W^m Mufee's transactions as trustee of account from the 1st day of August 1857, finds a balance of \$49.29 due from the trustee to the grantor. This Deed made this the 13th day of December 1857, between Robt. H. Whitfield (Trustee) party of the first part, John Edgerton of the second part Joshua Dugson of the third part and Asaell R. Mughart of the 4th part. Whereas by a deed dated the 20th of February 1857 and record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County the said John E. and Joshua Dugson in consideration of the payment of certain debts therein mentioned are owing to the said A. R. Mughart did convey in trust certain property set forth and described in said deed as follows viz a tract of land situated in said County, bounded by the lands of Thos. D. Byrd, Sol. Britt, John Brown, Patrick Dole, Jas. Harvey, containing by estimation two hundred and ninety acres of land also negro Nelson, house, stock of cattle, hogs, Sheep, hunchback and Ridesback furniture, of which property, the real estate belongs to the said John E. Dugson and the balance to the said Joshua Dugson. And as to the said real estate the wife of Joshua Dugson having her rights of descent, the same was subsequently conveyed to the said Whitfield for the benefit and objects of said trust. And whereas all of the said in the said deed of trust have been fully paid off and satisfied and the said John Edgerton desires the said real estate in said trust Deed mentioned be released to him and the said Joshua Dugson the said personal estate such part thereof as now remains be released to him. Now therefore this Deed witnesseth that the said Robt. H. Whitfield in consideration of the premises and by and with the consent of the said Asaell R. Mughart desirous to by his execution of this Deed, doth grant and release unto the said John E. Dugson the tract of Land above mentioned and described containing as aforesaid about 290 acres and his heirs and be also releases unto the said Joshua Dugson the said negro Nelson other personal estate above mentioned in such part thereof as remains that is to say, all such right title and interest in & to the same as vested in him the said Robt. H. Whitfield aforesaid with special warranty. And the said Asaell R. Mughart releases to the said parties all of his claims in the said property to them respectively or as they severally claim the same. Whitherso the following signatures and seals
