This Deed made the 29th day of December 1857, between William Beale of the one part and John S. Boykin trustee of the other part witnesseth that the said William Beale doth grant unto the John S. Boykin trustee, the following property in trust of Land containing by estimation 300 acres known as the Jas. Compton tract and the sum of £100 if that may be, from sale of property that has been conveyed by former deeds of trust made by said Wm. Beale in trust to whom Allen Stephenson and E. N. Williams in the sum Nineteen Thousand Dollars as security for said Wm. Beale for his due & 500 Hhds Canner of Emma Branach and Eliza F. Stephenson & James D. Biggs heir in the sum of Fifty Dollars due by note. The condition of the above obligation is cash that if the said William Beale fails to pay the debt before named when demanded the said John S. Boykin trustee shall after given ten days notice sell for cash the above named plantation and with the proceeds thereof satisfy said Allen Stephenson, E. N. Williams & A. F. Stephenson & if a balance remains pay J. D. Biggs out his debt. Witness the following signature and seals

Lyne has granted to the said Charles Beale a certain water grist Mill with about one hundred acres of Land therewith attached lying in the County of Southampton known as Morris Hill of which Henry Moore did own which said Mill & Land were conveyed to the said Neuron Lyne by deed from John T.
