Mary, his wife, of the one part and William Weston of the other part, witness
ethat the said Thomas Drake & Mary his wife, in consideration of \$500
hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by
William Weston at or before the executing and delivery of these presents, have
bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell
unto the said W^m Weston his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land
lying in the County of Southampton containing one hundred and ten acres be the same more
or less bounded by the lands, front; On the east by the lands of Elijah Jagers and
the said William Weston on the north by the lands of Maria Drake and John
Jagers (widow of Matthew Jagers) and west by the lands of Nathaniel Weston
south by the lands of Jesse Blythe and the tract of land called Raley's
tract. To have and to hold the one hundred and ten acres of land unto the
said William Weston his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas Drake
& Mary his wife for themselves and their heirs this said one hundred and ten acres
of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before be-
longing unto the said William Weston his heirs and assigns free from the debt
or claims of them the said Thomas Drake and Mary his wife or either of them
their or either of their heirs and of all and every person's persons whatsoever shall
will and do present and forever defend by their presents. In witness whereof the said
