This deed made the 20th day of January in the year of our Lord 1858, between Jordan Stewart of the one part and William Whitehead of the other part, witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars in hand paid to the said Stewart by said Whitehead at or before the sealing of these presents, the said Stewart doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Whitehead all his right, title and interest in a certain tract or parcel of land adjoining the lands of the said William Whitehead, John Rice, & Robert Whitehead and containing twenty seven acres more or less, together with all the appurtenances thereto appertaining that the said grantor Stewart doth release to the said grantee Whitehead all his
