This Deed made the 26th day of January in the year 1856, between Manfield Hines (the grantor) of the one part, and Robert M. Dolos, trustee, of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Manfield Hines the grantor doth grant unto the said Robert M. Dolos, trustee, the following property one tract of land containing by estimation 276 Acres be the same more or less lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and being as follows on the north by the land of Thomas Mumble on the east by the land belonging to the heirs of Frank Battle on the south by the land of said heirs of Frank Battle, on the west by Horse pond Swamp, also one Horse and buggy, Stock of Hogs, Stock of Cattle, Cart and wheels, harness and kitchen furniture in trust to secure the following debts due to Robert M. Dolos, one bond of six hundred dollars due the 26th day of January 1855. The said parties to the above agreement covenanted to pay the trustee (Robert M. Dolos) the sum of five per cent on all the
