Whitehead of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the other part, Witnesseth that Thomas H. Brantly of the County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and forty dollars to me in hand paid by the said John M. Whitehead, the receipt of which I do hereby acknowledge, have bargained, sold and confirmed unto by these presents doth bargain sell and convey unto him the said John M. Whitehead his heirs and assigns forever two certain tracts or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Bounded as follows, to wit: one tract on the south of Foxe's branch which is to be the line on the East, North and west by the lands of the said John M. Whitehead containing Eight Acres more or less and one other tract or parcel bounded on the South by the Seaboard and R. R. West by the Incheuring River, South by the lands of the said John M. Whitehead and East by the lands of John M. Whitehead containing Sixteen Acres more or less. To have and to hold said land with all and singular the appurtenances and I the said Herman L. Brantly doth further bind myself my heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend the right and title of said Land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereon or in any wise appertaining to be good unto him the said John M. Whitehead his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claim or claims of all and every person or persons whomsoever.
