 fifty seven, between Narcissus D. Pope Born E. Pope, and wife Clarine R. Pope
 of the one part and John W. Mumper of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said
Born E. Pope wife Clarine and the said Narcissus D. Pope (grantors) for and
 in consideration of the sum of Three thousand and five hundred dollars to them paid by
 the said Mumper, the receipt of which sum is hereby acknowledged, do hereby sell
 grant and convey to the said John W. Mumper (grantee) one undivided half
 moiety of the whole the interest which the said grantors may have in and to a cer-
 tain tract or parcel of land which the said grantors have lately purchased and called
 and known as the "Brown place" lying upon the Northway river in the County of
Southampton, the whole of said tract now containing eleven hundred and eleven acres
 (the said grantors having heretofore sold and granted a portion of the said tract
 to one Joseph G. Crumpler which is specially described in the deed to said Crumpler
 by metes and bounds) - the said tract one undivided half of which the said grantors
 now desire and intend to convey to the said Mumper is bounded by the lands of John
B. Jenkins, Oliver R. Fries, John C. Beale's heirs, John M. Gentry, Joseph G.
Crumpler & others & by the said Northway river. And the said grantors warrant
 specially and generally the title to the land hereby conveyed.
