

This Deed made this 23^d day of March in the year 1858, between Robert J. Fitch of e Am. Co. his wife of the one part and Theophilus Little of the other part, Whitefield; that she said Robert J. Fitch of e Am. Co. his wife do grant unto the said Theophilus Little the following property, To wit: a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing Two hundred and seventy five acres more or less being the tract of land which the said Fitch purchased of Jesse Little by deed admitted to record the 20th day of October 1856 One horse, one mule, 40 head of hogs, one yoke of oxen one cow, and the increase of said hogs & cow, also all his the said Fitch household & kitchen furniture. In trust to secure a debt due Jesse Little by bond executed the 20th day of October 1856 to wit: John M. Guley is security for eleven hundred & eighty five dollars with interest from date thereof. And it is hereby agreed by all parties that she said Robert J. Fitch is to retain possession of the above named property until the 25th day of December 1858 and to take the profits thereof to his own use, and should the debt aforesaid then be unpaid it is shall be the duty of the said Theophilus Little at any time thereafter being thereto required by the said Robert J. Fitch of Jesse Little or either of them, after giving reasonable public notice thereof to make sale of the property above conveyed, the land upon a credit of twelve months of the personal property for cash, and out of the moneys arising from said sale first pay all expenses of the sale of this conveyance, then pay the debt due Jesse Little above named with all interest due thereon and the balance if any pay to the said Robert J. Fitch. And the said Robert J. Fitch warrants generally the property above conveyed.

This Deed made this 27th day March in the year 1858 between James St. Dupont of the one part and Thomas J. Brister of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whitefield that the said James St. Dupont doth grant unto the said Thomas J. Brister the following property, To wit: one gray horse eight barrels corn, 1200 pounds hams, for beer 3000 lbs bacon one cart wheels one cow seven pigs, seven sheeps, one cow & calf, two feather beds & furniture, one mattress, two tables, 8 chairs one bureau, one cupboard, pots & oven and squirrel gun, Crockery ware &c. In trust to secure a debt due William J. Stephenson for twenty four dollars and ¹²/₁₀₀ cents by bond executed the 27th day of March 1858, a debt due A. S. St. Paul for twenty two dollars & sixty cents by account a debt due Julian J. Branch about of e Fitcher W. Balloum due for twenty eight Dollars and twenty five cents by bond executed the 27th November 1857, payable six months after date a debt due Levi W. Stephenson given to William H. Holden fifty dollars by bond executed 12th day of February 1858, payable all the first day of January 1859, a debt due Murdoch M. May in guard for thirty seven dollars & fifty cents by bond executed 12th day February 1858 payable the 1st day of January 1859.
