

This Deed made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March in the year 1858, between Robert J. Fish of Amherst Co.  
 his wife of the one part and Theophilus Little of the other part, witnesseth; that the said  
 Robert J. Fish & his wife do grant unto the said Theophilus Little the following pro-  
 perty, First; a certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and con-  
 taining Two hundred and seventy five acres more or less being the tract of land which the said  
 Fish purchased of Jeptha Little by deed admitted to record the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October 1856  
 One horse, one mule, 40 head of hogs, one yoke of oxen one cow, and the increase  
 of said hogs & cow, also all his the said Fish's household & kitchen furniture. In trust  
 to secure a debt due Jeptha Little by bond executed the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October 1856 to which  
 Mr. Guile is security for eleven hundred & Eighty five dollars with interest from & at  
 thence. And it is hereby agreed by all parties that the said Robert J. Fish is to retain  
 possession of the above named property until the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1858 and to take the  
 profits thereof to his own use, and should the debt aforesaid then be unpaid it is shall  
 be the duty of the said Theophilus Little at any time thereafter being there required by  
 the said Robert J. Fish or Jeptha Little or either of them, after giving reasonable public notice  
 thereof to make sale of the property above conveyed. The land upon a credit of twelve months  
 & the personal property for cash, and out of the monies arising from said sale first pay all  
 expenses of the sale of this conveyance, then pay the debt due Jeptha Little aforesaid with  
 all interest due thence and the balance if any pay to the said Robert J. Fish. And  
 the said Robert J. Fish warrants generally the property above conveyed.

This Deed made this 27<sup>th</sup> day March in the year 1858 between James H. Gibson of the  
 one part and Thomas J. Bristow of the other part both of the County of Southampton  
 and State of Virginia. Witnesseth the said James H. Gibson doth grant unto the said  
 Thomas J. Bristow the following property, First; one gray house eight lands & cow,  
 1200 pounds lbs. forster \$100 lbs bacon one cart wheels & iron & seven pigs, Seven  
 sheep, one cow & calf, two feather beds of furniture, one mattock, two tables, 8 chairs  
 one bureau, one cupboard, pots of iron and copper, crockery ware &c. Interest  
 to secure a debt due Mr. William G. Stephenson for twenty four dollars and 46 cents by  
 bond executed the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1858, a debt due A. S. St. Georges for twenty two  
 dollars & Sixty cents by account a debt due Julian J. Branch above of a Father & C.  
 St. Georges dec'd. for twenty eight Dollars and twenty five cents by bond executed the 27<sup>th</sup>  
 November 1857, payable six months after date a debt due Lure W. Stephenson going  
 to Mr. William H. Holden fifty dollars by bond executed 12<sup>th</sup> day of February 1858, pay  
 all the first day of January 1859, a debt due Mr. John M. May ten guineas for  
 thirty seven dollars & fifty cents by bond executed 12<sup>th</sup> day February 1858, pay all  
 the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June aym 1859.
