This Deed made this 30th day of March in the year 1858 between James Gurley
the one part and Henry S. Howard of the other part, witnesseth, that the said
James Gurley doth grant unto the said Henry S. Howard the trustee as aforesaid
following property: "All my crops for the present year consisting of
corn, fodder, cotton, peas, potatoes &c and all my stock of every description
consisting of about forty five hogs & their increase eighteen head of cattle and the
increase. In trust to secure the payment of above due amount and expenses
the said James Gurley to Edwin Williams for the sum of One hundred dollars
dated the 16th day of March 1857, and payable on demand or much less than
a credit of twenty dollars paid January 18th 1858. And the said James Gurley
covenants with the said Henry S. Howard, trustee, as aforesaid that he will
warrant generally the property herein conveyed.

of the sum of one hundred and seventy eight dollars and fifty cents to the grantee paid by
the grantee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said grantors do
hereby grant and convey to the said grantee with general warranty a certain tract
of land lying in said County containing fifty acres more or less "beginning at
the corner in the ditch by the mill pond of Charles Baile, East by the line of
Augustus Smith - South by the line of Nathan N. Thomas - West by same
and the said grantors covenant to make all further assurances that may be
legal &c.
