 the one part and Henry S. Howard of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said
 James Guley hath grant unto the said Henry S. Howard the trustee as aforesaid
 following property: "All my crops for this present year consisting of Corn,
 Wheat, fodder, cotton, peas, potatoes &c and all my stock of every description
 consisting of about forty five hogs & their increase eighteen head of cattle and their
 increase. Intend to secure the payment of above due and owing and yet to wit of
 the said James Guley to Edwin Williams for the sum of Three hundred dollars
 dated the 1st day of March 1857, and payable on demand which bond there is
 a credit of twenty dollars paid July 15th 1858 And the said James Guley
 covenants with the said Henry S. Howard, trustee, as aforesaid that he will
 warrant generally the property herein conveyed.
