This deed made this third day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five between Allen C. Jynne (grantor) of the first part, and Benjamin B. Knives (trustee) of the other part; Witnesseth, that the said grantor hereby grants and conveys to the said trustee the following property to wit: the house and lot now occupying the said grantor at Boykin's Depot with all the buildings &c. thereon, as more fully described in a deed of land say about fifty acres lately purchased of Emma Piquet and lying near Boykin's Depot all the said grantor's household and kitchen furniture of every kind and every house - Intend to secure the following creditors and debtors of the said grantor. To secure in the first place a debt due by bond or note to Cuthbert D. Baskham dated in the year 1853 for about one thousand eight hundred and forty dollars, two cents. Said Baskham free from all loss as security for said grantor to John F. Powell in a debt of about five hundred dollars, and also free from loss in all other instances in which said Baskham may be security for said grantor.

To secure in the second place George T. James and Newsum R. Jynne as securities to a debt of about three hundred dollars due to Peter Edwards in to secure the payment of said debt.

But it is expressly stipulated and agreed by all the parties hereto that the said grantor shall remain in peaceable possession of all the said property for the space of eighteen months - At the end of that time the same may be sold according to law, by the trustee who shall pay the debts and liabilities as herein directed reserving five per cent commission pay over the residue to said grantor. This deed made the 3^d day of April in the year 1855 between Thomas Drury and Priscilla his wife of the one part and James G. Jones all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of eighty four dollars paid by James G. Jones to them the said Thomas Drury and Priscilla Drury, the said Thomas Drury and Priscilla his wife do grant unto the said James G. Jones all their right, title and interest in a certain parcel of land bounded as follows (to wit) by 19 acres more or less commencing at pine tree on Drury's line, thence 37 7/8 degrees west 193 poles to a maple in Tenequin Branch corner tree between James G. Jones, Thomas Drury and Robert Hart, thence down Tenequin Branch to James G. Jones original line in consideration of the sum above mentioned of eighty four dollars the said Thomas Drury and Priscilla his wife do likewise grant unto the said James G. Jones one other parcel of land containing by estimation 7 acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows commencing at a small red oak corner tree between James G. Jones, Thomas Drury and Henry Drake, thence west to a small red oak in James G. Jones' original line the said Thomas Drury and Priscilla his wife do specially warrant and defend the title and right to the above mentioned parcels of land to James G. Jones and his heirs forever.
