This Deed made this 18th day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven, between Thomas Hunt and Willy Hunt, his wife, of the one part and Leroy Whifford of the other part all of the County of Southampton & State of Va. Wittenpeck, that the said Thomas Hunt of Willy Hunt, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars in Cash paid to the said Thomas Hunt by the said Leroy Whifford the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; Have granted bargained and sold and do by this deed grant, bargain, sell of leasory to the said Leroy Whifford that tract of land lying in the County of Southampton State of Va. and bounded as follows: on the North & Northwest by the lands of James Bowing bay to the run of the Cypress Creek up said Creek to John R. Rockellis land there being said Cypress Creek along said Rockellis land to William Drakes, then along said Drakes line to Jason Gloris land, then along Jason Gloris line to the land known as the Bryant land, then along a line of marked trees of said Bryant's land to the run of the aforesaid Cypress Creek (supposed to contain) One hundred & forty acres more or less and known as the Whifford place & bequeathed to us by the last will & testament of Jacob Barnes Dec^d together with all and every privilege to have and to hold the said land of all the privileges rights & appurtenances belonging thereto unto him the said Leroy Whifford his heirs & assigns in fee simple, and the said Thomas Hunt for himself and his heirs doth hereby covenant & agree to & with the said Leroy Whifford his heirs & assigns the said tract of land hereby conveyed together with all & every privilege rights & appurtenances thereto belonging against the claim & demand of him Thomas Hunt & Willy Hunt his wife & their heirs and against the claim & demand of all & every person whatsoever shall & will by this deed forenow warrant & defend the said lands to the said Leroy Whifford and his heirs.
