This indenture made on this 28th day of November year one thousand eight hundred fifty
seven, between James Barnes of the one part & Everett Baynt of the County of Southampton
Vt. of the other part. that whereas the said James Barnes by virtue of a decree
of the County Court of the aforesaid County and in complying legally with the requirements
of said decree did sell a portion of land belonging to the estate of Jacob Barnes late
lying in the County of Southampton State of Vt. and bounded as follows beginning
at William Jagger's Cornet in the mill path in Everett Baynt line thence along
said Jagger's line of bounded trees N 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 109 poles to a corner stone S 95 $\frac{1}{2}$
38 poles to a red oak, thence S 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to the edge of Barnes Field from thence
the Rail Road a corner for said William Jagger thence down the mill path in line

diments to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto the said Sixty one
half acre more or less as above specified to have and to hold the said Everett
Baynt his heirs & assigns in as full & ample manner as he the said James Barnes
as Commissioner is possessed by virtue of said decree to convey and above
the same.
