This Deed made this seventh day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight, between Allen E. Jagers & Co. (merchants - the firm composed of Allen E. Jagers and Simon Jagers) of the first part and Benjamin B. Hinder (trustee) of the other part; witnesseth, that the said A. E. Jagers & Co. (grantors) do hereby grant and convey to the said trustee the following property, to-wit: the entire stock of every description whatever of dry goods groceries hardware, tin ware, tools, wares and all other merchandise of every kind now in store of said firm for King's Deft. - Stock of hogs and cattle - carts and one buggy with harness, farming implements of every kind - all bonds, notes, open accounts, and all other debts due to the said firm. In trust to secure the following debts and securities. In the first place to secure a debt due by bond or note to Leithbert D. Bacham for two thousand one hundred and seventy four dollars dated in the year 1857, and to secure a debt due by bond to and for five hundred dollars dated June the 7th 1858, to secure the said Bacham as security for said firm to Richard Darden for about eight hundred dollars due by bond (and to secure the said Bacham free from all loss in all instances in which he may be security for said firm, by bond, note or otherwise -

In the second place a debt due to Simonson R. Jagers by said firm for about eleven hundred and fifty dollars - and also to secure the said A. R. Jagers free from loss as security for said firm in all instances whatever.

In the third place to secure a debt due by said firm to Lucy W. Hubert for about three hundred dollars due by bond.
