 ampton and Parish of Saint Luke's containing two hundred and fifteen acres or
 the same more or less and bounded by the lands of said Seth St. Bishop and
 the land here purchased of John M. Curley and by the land of John M.
 Bishop's heirs: To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel
