This Deed made this 18th day of June in the year 1858, Between Nancy Whitney of the first part, Louisa M. Whitney of the second part and Gran Griffin Trustee of the third part, witnesseth, that the said Nancy Whitney doth grant unto the said Gran Griffin trustee, all right, title and interest in one certain tract of land formerly owned by William Payne, deceased, Robert G. Griffin the son and John C. Griffin d^r. The said tract of land contains four hundred and twenty three acres, of which the said Nancy Whitney is entitled by law to one third part of said land. And the said Nancy Whitney doth grant unto the said Gran Griffin trustee her proportion of said land for the benefit of the said Louisa M. Whitney in part pay of me bond which the said Louisa M. Whitney holds against the said Nancy Whitney. The amount of said bond is seven hundred dollars, bearing date the 1st day of November 1849.
