

I, Durlage also covenants all my right, title and interest in the aforesaid lot of lots with the aforesaid R. Bassett his heirs and assigns as security for the above amount of one thousand dollars in case the above restriction is forfeited. The said R. Bassett also binds myself, heirs & assigns to erect or have erected under the above condition suitable buildings for a family on the aforesaid lot or at least a family dwelling to be not less than two stories high and to be worth not less than five hundred dollars and my other lands or as many as he the said Durlage may think proper to build. If the said Durlage my heirs & assigns never does keep or cause to be kept any private or public Ordinary house on the aforesaid lot and have the dwelling house built as above then the above obligation is null and void otherwise remains in full force and virtue.
