Griffin of the other, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred & fifty four 21/100 Dollars to him in hand paid at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained, sold and granted unto Wiley H. Griffin now of the city of Baltimore in the State of Maryland, One certain tract or parcel of land lying and being near a lake and bounded by the lands of Dempsey Johnson, Abner Shedd, Ed Jordan Edwards, Harrison Tigner, Betsey Beale and Lucy Orroy, to have and hold the said land with all its premises and appurtenances unto Wiley H. Griffin, and the said John Britton for himself heirs and assigns, doth warrant the right and title thereof to the said Wiley H. Griffin his heirs and assigns to be good, free from him the said John Britton or his heirs and assigns and from all and every other person persons whatsoever.
