This Indenture made and entered into this 9th day of August 1858, between Job Holland of the first part, John Burham of the second part and George L. Dole of the third part all of the County of Westmoreland and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Job Holland is indebted to the said George L. Dole by Bond bearing even date with this Indenture in the sum of Four hundred and eighty nine dollars and the said Job Holland being willing and desirous to secure the said debt and interest. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of one dollar to him the said Job Holland and his heirs paid by the said John Burham at and before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Job Holland that he has given and sold and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell unto the said John Burham his heirs and assigns forever the following property to-wit: Growing Crop, Corn, feed &c., Peas, Shucks & Potatoes one hundred Horse one mule, one yearling, one Cow & furniture, sixteen forty head hogs and their gain, sixteen three beds and furniture, one folding Table, six sitting chairs, one rocking chair three chest three trunks, four beds, three ovens, one shot gun, one Cart of four wheels, one bridge & saddle, one wheel Barrow, five ploughs & plough Hoes & Cornhusk six axes and six Gulch hoes, four cutting axes two sets plow gear, one sett Cart gear, one pair sad Irons one pair And Irons, shovel & Sings, Bark mill and tools all other articles of Household and Kitchen furniture, also all other farming implements not herein named. To have and to hold to the said John Burham his heirs proper use and behoof forever upon trust nevertheless that the said John Burham shall at the request of either one of the after said parties after giving at least ten days notice of the time and place of sale, sell at public auction all the property herein named and set thereof as shall be sufficient to satisfy said debt and interest, and out of the proceeds, first pay the expenses thereof, then pay George L. Dole his debt with interest and the balance if any pay over to the said Job
