

In trust to indemnify and save from all loss or damage Leticia R. Edwards
 Wm. W. Briggs and John J. Howard who are bound as securities for the said
 Parker to an indemnifying or refunding bond executed to Frederick Jones
 others to whom said Parker sold and conveyed a tract of land lying in Swain
 County North Carolina which said tract of land was acquired by the said
 Parker by his marriage with his present wife who was, Clara Debing,
 who being then (and now) under the lawful age of twenty one years was
 is incapable of making her relinquishment thereof; The said Parker
 therefore executed this said bond to the said Jones (and others the purchasers
 of the said land to indemnify the said purchasers from all loss in the event of

 trustee of the second part witnesseth that the said Parker doth grant and convey
 to the said Howard the following property viz: one negro man, Ned, one
 negro boy Sam one negro woman Lina, one negro girl Adeline;
 one bay horse (Amg) one bay mare (Juba) and colt; entire stock of
 hogs and cattle, one baggy and harness, one Sully and harness, one double
 set of baggy and harness, one cart and gear, plows and farming utensils,
 and implements of every kind, household and kitchen furniture of every
 description viz: chairs, sofas, tables, beds, glass and crockery ware
 and every other kind now in possession of the said grantor, crops of corn,
 food, peas, potatoes and all other kinds whatever gathered or growing
 viz: one double barreled gun, one colts' revolver, one gold watch and
 chain.
