 Guley of the first part and Henry S. Howard of the second part of the said part of the said
 the said James Guley doth grant unto the said Henry S. Howard the following pro-
 perty, to wit: "All his present growing crop of this year and all that has
 been gathered, consisting of Peas, Corn, Godwin, Cotton, peas, potatoes,
 &c. He trust to secure the payment of about due growing and executed by the
 said James Guley to Edwin Williams for three hundred dollars and dated
 the 11th day of March 1857 and pay able in demand on which bond there
 is a credit of twenty dollars paid January 18th 1858, And the said James
 Guley covenants with the said Henry S. Howard that he will warrant generally
