This Deed made and entered into this 14th day of September in the year 1858,
between William M. Everett and Ann C. Everett, his wife, of the first part,
and Francis S. Ridley of the second part, all of the County of Southampton
State of Virginia, Oldeupark; that for and in consideration of the sum of
one hundred dollars paid by the said Ridley to the said Everett, the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged by the said Everett of the first part, has
given, granted, bargained and sold and do by these presents give grant, be-
gave and sell unto the said Ridley one hundred and nine acres of land mincluding
being a portion of the tract formerly owned by William Judkins dec'd and sold
by Mr. S. Goodman as commissioner in the chancery suit of Drury and others
against Riddley (or R. R. and others in the Circuit Court of the County aforesaid
and for which the said Goodman and John R. Davis executed to the said Everett
a deed dated the 20th day of May in the year 1858, (and b. and s. as fol-
lows testit; by the land of the said Francis S. Ridley, the Mill pond belonging
to the estate of Robt. Ridley dec'd the County road and the Mill path lead-
ing from the County road to R. Ridley's Mill and designated by line trees
being chose in each side of the Mill path. And the said Mr. M.
Everett for himself and his heirs covenants with the said Ridley and
hers that he will forever warrant and defend the title to the said land
against the claims of all persons.
