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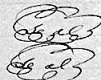

This Deed made this 20th day of September in the year 1855, between William P. Moore of the one part and Meredith Holland of the other. Whereas W^m J. Cobb and Anne Cobb, his wife, did on the 2nd of February 1853 by deed grant to W^m J. Moore a certain tract of land lying in Southampton County containing about 280 acres bounded by and adjoining the lands of W. C. Lawrence, the heirs of Richard Parker dead & Ed. Cobb and others for the sum of \$700 with general warranty and whereas Anne E. Cobb, at the time of the execution of the said deed was under the age of 21 years and had no being examination and relinquishment and whereas the said Anne E. Cobb has since her arriving at the age of 21 years to wit: on the 2nd day of August 1855, by her being examination and relinquishment before the Clerk of the County Court of Southampton in his office ratified and confirmed the said deed of the 2nd of February 1853 to W^m J. Moore, and whereas the said W^m J. Moore has sold the said land and after several sales it has come into the possession and ownership of Meredith Holland his heirs to which can be traced by examining the several deeds from W^m J. Moore down to him of record in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton and whereas the said W^m J. Moore desires to convey a full fee simple title to the said Meredith Holland, Now therefore this deed witnesseth that the said W^m J. Moore for the sum of one dollar doth grant unto the said Meredith Holland the said tract of land of 280 acres and transmitting to him all the title which has been conveyed to the said W^m J. Moore by the ratification of Anne E. Cobb of the 2nd of August 1855, Witness the following signatures and seals.

F.eland dec'd. did by his last will direct that the said Jos. H. Prince Esq. should purchase the land then held by Ethelred Marvel containing two hundred and eighty eight acres and upon which the said Ethelred had a deed of trust W^m A. Jones trustee and whereas the land did not sell
