

This Deed made this 15th day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight, between James Fagan and his wife, Elizabeth Jane, the first part, and John J. Andred of the other part, Witnesses, that the said Fagan and wife, for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred Dollars to them paid by the said Andred, the rec^d of which sum is hereby acknowledged, hath granted and conveyed to the said Andred that lot or parcel of land lying in the Town of Jerusalem, County of Southampton in which the said Fagan now resides containing one acre more or less, which is the same lot hereby conveyed by Magistrate to Jacob Thompson and is bounded on the North by the lot now owned by W^m B. Brown known as Cook's, on the east by the Main Street in said Village, on the south by a cross Street which separates it from the land belonging to the estate of James Rockelle Dec^d. and on the west by the Railroad now together with all the buildings, privileges and appurtenances in any wise belonging or attached to the said lot or parcel of land except the quantity of land owned by the Grove Yard which is not hereby conveyed. And the said Fagan and wife warrant generally the title to the property hereby conveyed. Witness the following signatures and seals
