This deed made this 23^d day of October 1855, between Bray Saunders
the grantor of the one part and Elijah Iogues the trustee of the other
part, witnesseth, that the said Bray Saunders doth grant unto the
said Elijah Iogues the following property, to wit: a tract of land lying
in Southampton County, containing two hundred and fourteen acres more
or less and firmly owned by Clements Rochelle, three houses and more
and their increase, stock of cattle, hogs, and sheep, crops of
corn, cotton and peas, grown this year, household and kitchen
furniture and all his other personal estate not herein named. In trust
to secure to William R. Saunders the sum of four hundred and
fifty dollars (\$450.) and to secure to James Alfred Sares
the sum of five hundred dollars due by bond and in the same place
thou pay all the debts due and owing by the said Bray Saunders
And the said Bray Saunders doth hereby warrant generally the property
hereby conveyed to the said Elijah Iogues.
