

This deed of Trust made the 21st day of October 1855, between James Gurley of the one part and Henry S. Howard of the second part, both of Southampton County, Virginia: Witnesseth, that the said James Gurley doth grant unto the said Henry S. Howard (Trustee) the following property, to-wit: Household & kitchen furniture, House & House Stock of all kinds, crops of Corn, Peas & Potatoes & fodder, apple & pearning, linen book farming utensils, Cart & wheels &c. (and all other property, subject to a former deed of trust given to Edwin Williams).

In trust to secure Richard J. Dusen in the sum of one Hundred & Fifty dollars due by notes (and Darden & Verke in the sum of eleven dollars & 5 cents due by account. Witness the following signatures & seals, the above day and date.

This deed made this 28th day of October one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight, between Parker Vick, Grantor of the one part and Ben. B. Kindred Trustee of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth that the said Parker Vick, grantor, doth grant unto the said Ben. B. Kindred Trustee, the following property, to-wit: crops of Corn, fodder and peas and potatoes and crops of every species made by me this year 1858 on the Mill farm, fourteen shoats, two sows & six pigs and their increase one mare and colt and their increase, one cow and her increase, cart and wheels, ploughs, plough hoes, wide hoes, and axes and all kinds of farming implements now belonging to me; household and kitchen furniture. In trust to secure to James McNeill (and Miles McNeill the following notes and accounts, to-wit: to James McNeill one note of seven dollars due 1st October 1858 one account of twenty one dollars due 1st January 1858, and one account of seventeen dollars and fifty cents due 28th November 1858 and to Miles McNeill one account of forty five dollars due 1st January 1858, one account of seventeen dollars and 50/100 due 28th October 1858 (and another account of about seventy five dollars more or less amount not rec'd collected due 1st January 1858, The said Parker Vick grantor warrants generally the title of the property hereby conveyed to the said Ben. B. Kindred Trustee, In Witness where have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and date above written
