

This Deed made this 8th day of July 1858 between Robert Murray & Elmira Murray his wife, of the one part and W^m W. Briggs of the other part witnesseth that the said Robert Murray & wife for the consideration of twenty seven hundred & fifty Dollars to them in hand paid by the said W^m W. Briggs, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth grant unto the said W^m W. Briggs all of that tract of Land whereon stood Robert Murray now ceased containing by estimation Six hundred & twenty nine & three fourths acres more or less, siting in the County of Southampton County, and the said Robert Murray purchased of Osmin Dick & wife as will appear by Deed bearing date 3rd April 1852. and of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, and the said Robert Murray & wife covenant with the said Briggs that they will forever warrant & defend the right and title to the above described land against the claim of themselves, their heirs, and all persons whatsoever. And the said Robert Murray & wife further covenant with the said W^m W. Briggs that they will deliver him possession of the above described land, with the same buildings and improvements thereon as now on said land.
