 Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of thirty six dollars 22 cents (and the said
 Isaac Bailey for debt granted to Patsy Bailey all that tract of land & premises lying &
 being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation 37 1/2 acres more or less of P^{rs} lands
 by the lands of the heir of A. P. D. Dand, of W^m at Harwood, April 1856.
 Robt Roberts for the right of title to said tract of land & premises, I the said Isaac
 Bailey do hereby warrant to the said Patsy Bailey & her heirs forever free from
 the claim of any self, & of all & every other person whatsoever claiming by title

This deed made this first day of April 1857, between Richard H. Baker Jr. Trustee
 of the first part, Adrian Camell and W^m R. Beane of the second part (and James
 W. Munfer of the third part. Whereas the said Adrian Camell and W^m R. Beane did
 on the first day of April 1856 convey to the said R. H. Baker Jr. by deed of trust
 of that date a certain tract of land in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia,
 called "Mead Hill" as particularly described in said deed in trust to become the home
 of James W. Munfer the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars, with interest thereon
 from the 3rd day of January 1856. And whereas the said Camell and Beane have this day
 paid to the said James W. Munfer the said sum of money and interest; Now this deed
 being witnessed that for and in consideration of the premises, the said R. H. Baker Jr. as
 trustee, as aforesaid, with the consent of the said James W. Munfer, the said
 executing these premises, doth release unto the said Camell and Beane all
 their and assigns forever, the tract of land aforesaid, and all claim in
 law or equity in or to the same; And the said James W. Munfer doth
