ginia Whitefield; that the Henry E. Jones doth grant unto the Brig^t 13 Kindred
trustee the following property, to wit; One Bay House, One Bay Barn and Gray Turkey,
all of his household and Kitchen furniture, Stock of all kinds, furniture implements &c &c
of all kinds. In trust to secure John R. Rockwell in the sum of Three Hundred dollars
due by bond bearing date the 1st day of Novr. 1858, and also to secure Bennett
Bennett in the sum of Twenty three dollars due by bond bearing date from
Nov 1st 1858, and also to secure Nathl. Jones in the sum of One Thousand
and forty dollars, due by bond bearing Date from the 1st day of Novr 1858, and
also to secure William in the sum of forty two dollars due by bond and
also to secure Elijah Joyner in the sum of Sixty dollars due by account, and
James J. Darden in the sum of Fifty Dollars due by account.

The above obligation is such that if the said Henry E. Jones shall fail to pay
when demanded the above named debts or any one of them - the said Brig^t 13 B. B.
Kindred by the direction of any one of the parties, shall after giving legal notice,
sell for cash the abovesigned property, and with the proceeds thereof pay off
discharge said debts and the pster if any, pay to the s^d Henry E. Jones,
