

This Deed of Trust made this 19th day of October 1855, between W^m H. Bishop of the first part and Robt. J. Fitch, Justice, of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said W^m H. Bishop doth convey into the said Robt. J. Fitch trustee the following property to wit: all my present crop, fodder, cotton, peas & potatoes, in the house, on cut of wheels, all my stock, cattle, & hogs, all my household & kitchen furniture, farming utensils &c. I do trust to secure the following debts in the first place to secure two debts on which suits have been brought and are now in the hands of Sheriff Due Geo. M. Bailey to which I do give as my security both debts amounting to about one hundred and fifty dollars and in the second place to secure all my other debts.
