


This deed made the 15 day November in the year 1858, between Patrick H. Rawlings of the
one part and Andrew J. Kello of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Patrick H. Rawlings
doth grant unto the said Andrew J. Kello the following property, to wit; one negro boy
named Peter one named Dick, one negro girl named Mary, one named Sally, one
negro girl named Edney, one negro boy named Harry also one tract of land called
the Gun tract on which the said Patrick H. Rawlings now resides containing
by estimation four hundred acres by the same more or less, also another of about two
hundred and forty acres by the same more or less called the Booth tract in trust
to bear Patrick Dolles in the sum of one hundred and the 15th day of November 1858
for eleven hundred dollars also one other bond due said P. Dolles the 1st day
of May 1859 for one thousand dollars also one bond due Saml Kello administrator
of the estate of W^m Prince due for two thousand two hundred and seventeen dollars
and ninety one cents due the 10th day of November 1858, also one unsettled
matter with Saml Kello amount supposed to be about two hundred dollars. The
condition of the above obligation is that the if the said Patrick H. Rawlings
should pay the interest accumulating on the above mentioned amounts the above
property shall not be sold within 12 months by the trustee Andrew J. Kello
Should the whole amount mentioned in the above claims principals and interest be not paid
at the expiration of two years from the date of this deed then the trustee Andrew J.
Kello or his substitute shall proceed to sell the above mentioned property until
